Playing and learning together

Major achievements and developments:

Purchase of the Church Lane building in December 2013 resulted in a major refurbishment of the premises and areas used by the children. A re-branding as St Michael's family Centre Church Lane has further taken place with the OfSTED registration changing to reflect this.

The Childcare provision has been reviewed and extended to provide more places for 2, 3 and 4 years olds.

Major achievements in childcare:

- 1 staff member achieved Early Years Teacher status.
- All staff have participated in INSET training to include Speech & Language and the Norfolk County lead talk about program.
- All staff have updated relevant mandatory qualifications risk assessment, first aid, moving and handling, safeguarding.

Nar and St Clements Children's Centre:

The family Centre has continued to work in partnership with the Nar and St Clements Children's Centre to delivery services as agreed within the service level agreement and as such provided funded and non- funded places for children within the reach area of the Children's Centre.
